Each year, dozens of measures that affect our rights and our lives come before the California State Senate and Assembly. Our elected officials make decisions about the right to choose a safe and legal abortion, comprehensive sexual education, access to reproductive health care and much more. Planned Parenthood Affiliates of California has designed this scorecard to help you hold your elected officials accountable on the issues that matter to you.

Description of Scored Legislation

The Sexual Health Education Accountability Act

AB 629 (Brownley): Requires that any publicly funded program providing information to prevent adolescent or unintended pregnancies and/or sexually transmitted diseases, must be medically accurate, current and objective.

Access to Maternity Coverage

AB 1328 (Hayashi): Eliminates eligibility barriers to the Access for Infants and Mothers (AIM) program.

Inmate and Community Public Health and Safety Act

AB 1334 (Swanson): Allows for non-profit or health agencies, including prisons, to distribute condoms without criminal penalty.

Human Papillomavirus Vaccination

AB 1429 (Evans): Mandates that insurance plans which cover cervical cancer treatment also cover cervical cancer vaccines.

Medi-Cal Funding

SB 94 (Kuehl): Augments the reimbursement rates for family planning office visits up to 80 percent parity with Medicare.

Assembly Budget Bill:

Abortion Funding

Three anti-choice amendments to the state budget that would do the following:

- Create a ban on certain abortion procedures.
- Eliminate minor's consent.
- Limit state funding of abortion services.
