PRO-CHOICE SCORECARD 2008

Each year, dozens of measures that affect our rights and our lives come before the California State Legislature. Our elected officials make decisions about the right to choose a safe and legal abortion, comprehensive sexual education, access to reproductive health care and much more. This year legislators will also be scored on whether they have endorsed the No on Proposition 4 Campaign for Teen Safety. Prop 4 requires parental notification before a minor terminates pregnancy and will go before voters in November.

Planned Parenthood Affiliates of California has designed this scorecard to help you hold your elected officials accountable on the issues that matter to you.

Description of Issues Scored

Parental Notification Initiative

Proposition 4: Threatens teen safety by mandating parental notification and waiting period prior to a minor terminating pregnancy.

Human Papillomavirus Vaccination

AB 16 (Evans): Mandates that insurance plans that cover cervical cancer treatment also cover cervical cancer vaccines.

Health Care Service Plans

AB 1155 (Huffman): Penalizes health plans for repeated underpayment or nonpayment of claims by physicians, clinics or other providers.

Access to Maternity Coverage

AB 1962 (De La Torre): Mandates maternity coverage for all health insurance plans regulated by the Department of Insurance.

Maintaining Clinic Licensure Process

AB 2010 (DeSaulnier): Clarifies that the provisional licensure law does not apply to affiliated clinics.

Mobile Clinic

SB 1213 (Ducheny): Updates the notification requirement for mobile clinics.

Anti-Reproductive Rights Crimes

SB 1770 (Padilla): Allows more time for training related to the FACE Act, including reporting and classification of anti-reproductive rights crimes.

Republican Budget Proposal

The proposal would have significant negative impacts on reproductive health care programs and patients' access to care.

Senate Budget Bill:

Abortion Funding

Three anti-choice amendments to the state budget that would do the following: 1) eliminate state funding for abortion providers, 2) require biased consent, and 3) require parental notification for minors.

Assembly Budget Bill:

Abortion Funding

Three anti-choice amendments to the state budget that would do the following: 1) require parental consent, 2) limit state funding of abortion services, and 3) create a ban on certain abortion procedures.
